Lundy's Lost Plants – can you find any of these?



Ivy Broomrape *Orobanche hederae* One of a number of parasitic plants which are very similar; this, or a closely-related species, may have been recorded in recent years. Beware confusion with the dried-up flower spikes of Wall Pennywort *Umbilicus rupestris*. Could be present in the Millcombe area, or along Beach Road.



Autumn Ladies' Tresses *Spiranthes spiralis*. A small, white-flowered and delicately-scented orchid which flowers late in the season, so look for this in August and September. It favours short grass and dry, sunny conditions, and has been reported near the Castle.
